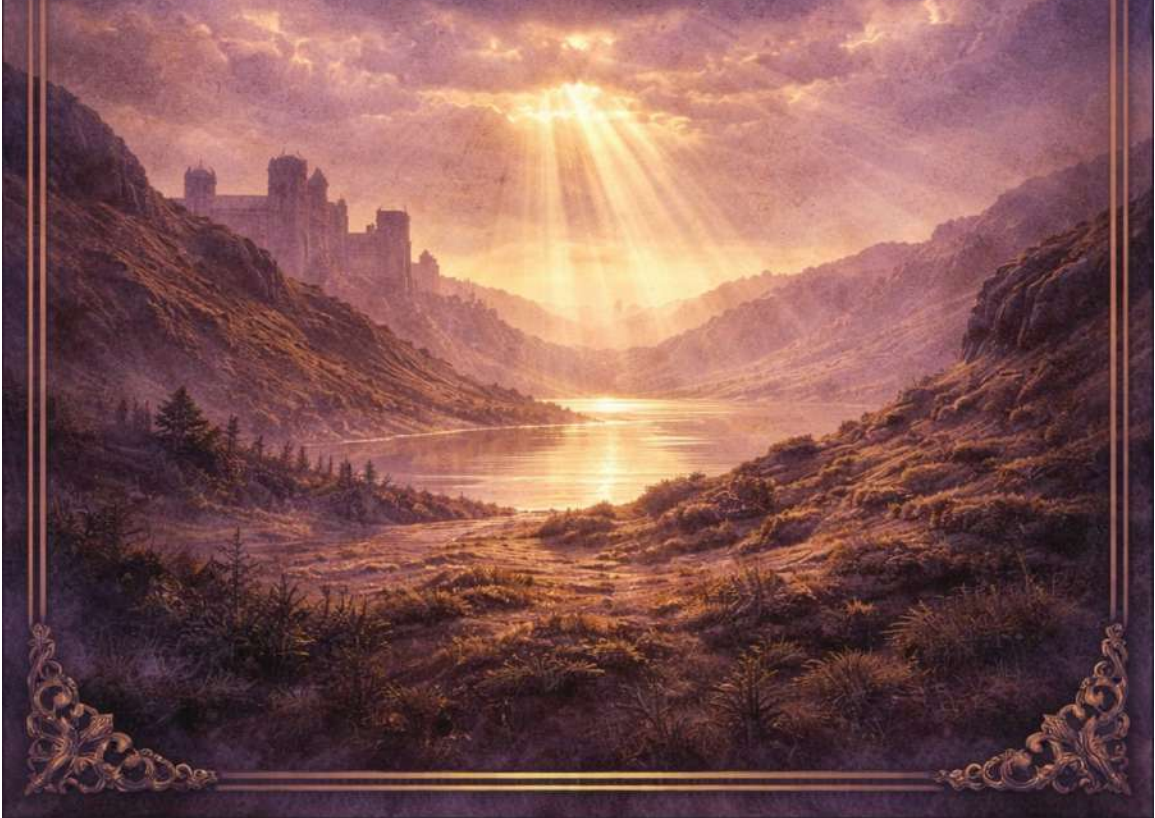

When God Feels Silent

Hi, Daughter ■

There are moments in your life when heaven feels quiet.

Not peaceful quiet...

But the kind that makes you wonder if your prayers are reaching anywhere at all.

You've been speaking.

You've been asking.

You've been waiting.

And still... nothing.

No clear answer.

No sign.

No movement.

Just silence.

And if you're honest, it's hard.

Because you don't just want God when things are going well—

You want Him here, in this moment.

In the uncertainty.

In the not knowing.

But can I gently offer you something to hold onto?

God's silence is not His absence.

He has not stepped away.

He has not closed His ears to you.

And He has not forgotten what you've placed before Him.

Sometimes, God is working in ways that don't come with noise.

Ways that don't announce themselves right away.

Sometimes, He is:

- aligning things you cannot yet see
- protecting you from what you don't yet understand
- preparing you for what you've been praying for
