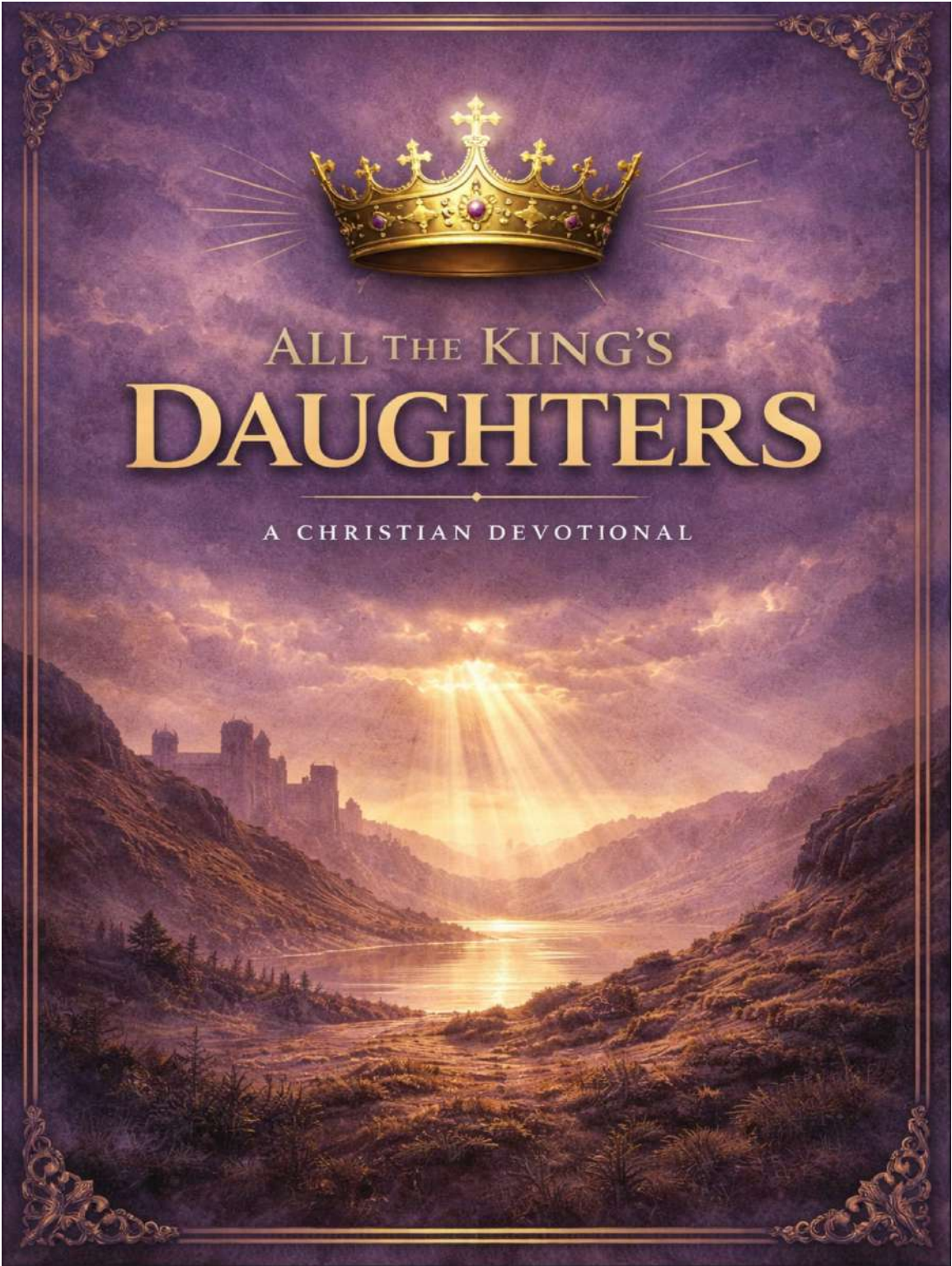

Peace in the Waiting

Hi, Daughter ■

Waiting is one of the hardest places to be.

Not because nothing is happening...
But because you don't know when something will.

You've prayed.
You've trusted.
You've placed it in God's hands.

And now... you wait.

In between what was spoken...
And what will be fulfilled.

And if you're honest, this space can feel heavy.

Because waiting can look like:
- doors not opening
- answers not coming
- things staying the same longer than you expected

And slowly, questions begin to rise:

Did I hear God correctly?
Did I miss something?
Why is this taking so long?

Waiting is not where God forgets you. Waiting is where God forms you.

There is a kind of peace that only grows here.

But the kind that comes from learning to trust even when nothing is moving yet.

Because while you are waiting...

God is not idle.

He is:
